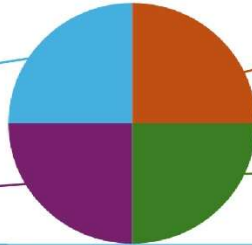

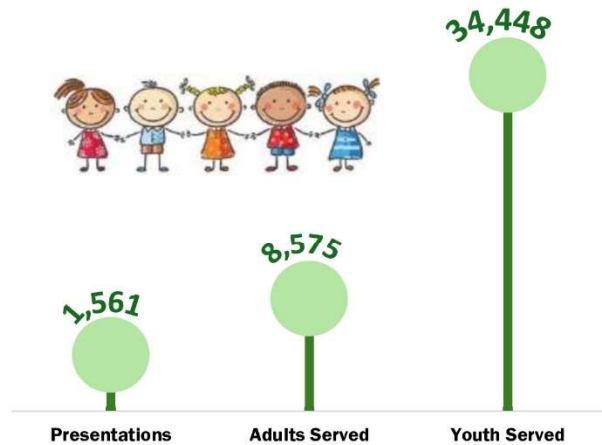

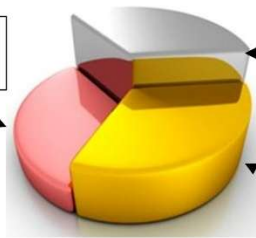


INTERVENTION SERVICES

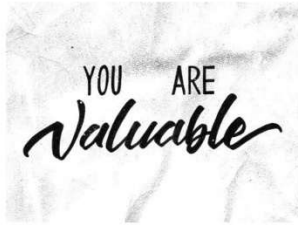

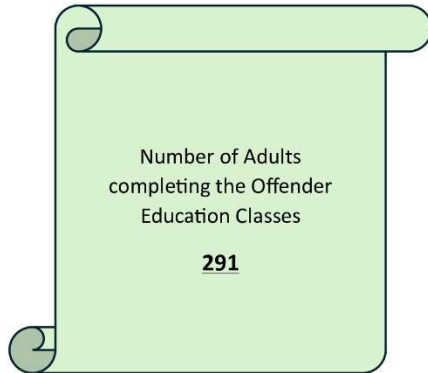


ADULT CRIMINAL JUSTICE TREATMENT
